How to Apply

Please send the following materials to Roots Renewal Counseling.

- 1. A mock counseling session
 - a. Assume that basic background information was already collected on an intake form, that you have already reviewed this information prior to the session, and you are generally aware of your client's presenting issues.
 - b. Assume that your client has already signed the confidentiality agreement.
 - c. Your mock counseling session should focus on developing rapport, goal formulation, and basic counseling skills.
 - d. Unless required by your program, your mock client is not required to sign a consent for videotaping.

- 2. Letter of intent, including statement of professional objectives for the practicum or clinical fellowship
- 3. Current curriculum vitae
- 4. Accepted applicants will be required to have a recent clear criminal background prior to starting their practicum at RRC.
